Notice for Anti – Ragging

In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. gg7/2009, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (g) of sub-section (1") of section 26 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, the UGC notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009'. The Regulations are available on the UGC website i.e. <u>www.ugc.ac.in</u> & <u>www.antiragging.in</u>.

It is once again brought to the notice of all that ragging is a criminal offence and UGC has framed regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. These regulations are mandatory and all institutions are required to take necessary steps for its implementation including the monitoring mechanism' Any violation of these regulations will be viewed seriously. If any institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or does not act in accordance with these Regulations or fails to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitably, it will attract punitive action against itself by the UGC.

- Click on "Click here to download the Anti-Ragging Affidavit" for website <u>www.antiragging.in</u> or "online Affidavit" for website <u>www.amanmovement.org</u> and read the instructions carefully.
- > Fill the Anti-Ragging Undertaking Form and submit it online.
- > You will receive the Student, Parent Undertaking at your Email-id as attachments.
- > Download the Undertakings, take the Printout, sign it (Self attested) and submit to the college at the time of admission.


